Oxford Road 2 (Dundas Street) reconstruction

Intersection of Oxford Road 2 (Dundas Street) and Oxford Road 12 (Mill Street / Oxford Street) in Woodstock will be closed for four weeks for Phase 2B of construction

About this project

Oxford County is continuing road reconstruction work on Oxford Road 2 (Dundas Street) in the City of Woodstock. While Phase 2A is in progress, **Phase 2B is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of September 14.** Please note, this date is subject to change; for the most up-to-date information, visit www.oxfordcounty.ca/construction

The project is expected to be completed by November 2026 and is being carried out in three (3) phases:

Phase 1: Oxford Road 2 from Oxford Road 30 (11th Line) and Oxford Road 9. Phase 1 began in April and was completed on July 28, 2026.

Phase 2A: Oxford Road 2 from Oxford Road 9 to west of Oxford Road 12. Phase 2A is in progress and is expected to be completed in November 2026.

Phase 2B: Intersection of Oxford Road 2 and Oxford Road 12. The intersection will be subject to a temporary four (4) week closure and is expected to begin the week of September 14, 2026.

Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

The full scope of work for this project includes:

- Full road reconstruction including full watermain replacement and size upgrade, and select storm and sanitary replacement and size upgrade;
- Replacement of concrete curb, gutter and sidewalks;
- Improved northbound right turn lane at Oxford Road 9 and Oxford Road 2;
- Intersection improvements at Oxford Road 2 and Oxford Road 12;
- Additional traffic calming measures; and,
- Pedestrian crossing at the west end of Oxford Road 2, just east of the overhead rail bridge near Youth Start Trail.

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How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

During construction, different sections of Oxford Road 2 will be closed between Oxford Road 30 and Oxford Road 12. Traffic will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services. A detour route will be in place for all three phases of construction:

Main detour: Oxford Road 30, Oxford Road 17 and Oxford Road 59 (Vansittart Avenue).

In addition to the detour noted above, detours will be in place during Phase 2A and 2B:

Phase 2A detour: Oxford Road 9, Main Street and Oxford Road 12.

Phase 2B detour: Oxford Road 9, Main Street and Oxford Road 59 (Wilson Street).

Garbage, organics and recycling

Access for waste collection is expected to be affected during construction. The contractor will collect homeowner containers and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark garbage, organics and recycling containers with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Water and sanitary sewer interruptions

Residents within the work area can expect both planned and unplanned water and sanitary sewer interruptions. Every attempt will be made to notify residents in advance.

Private sprinkler systems, landscaping or fencing

Please remove all items on Oxford County property in advance of construction. The County is not responsible for damage to private landscaping items located on County property.

Lawn restoration

Following construction, the contractor will place new sod on affected properties and water it as needed for 30 days after placement. After the 30 days, the sod maintenance and watering is the responsibility of the property owner, as it was prior to construction.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.

During Phase 2A, traffic travelling north on Oxford Road 9 will have access to Oxford Road 2 travelling west (left turn). Traffic travelling east on Oxford Road 2 will have access to Oxford Road 9 travelling south (right turn). All other access will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services. Non-local traffic should use the detours.
