Culvert replacements on Oxford Road 59 in Township of East Zorra-Tavistock

Oxford Road 59 will be closed between William St S (Tavistock) and Oxford Road 8 for culvert replacements

Oxford County has awarded a contract to Steve Smith Construction for culvert replacements on Oxford Road 59 between William St S (Tavistock) and Oxford Road 8 in the Township of East Zorra-Tavistock. The work includes culvert replacements and restoration work as required to be completed in two phases:

Phase 1: Between William Street S and Oxford Road 28 (Maplewood Sideroad)

Phase 2: Between Oxford Road 28 and Oxford Road 8

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in mid-June and be completed by mid-July. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

Culvert replacements will take place on Oxford Road 59 between William St S (Tavistock) and Oxford Road 8.

Phase 1 detour: William St S (13th Line), Oxford Road 28 (Maplewood Sideroad)

Phase 2 detour: Oxford Road 28 (Maplewood Sideroad), 16th Line, Oxford Road 8

The contractor will be required to maintain access as best as possible to all properties. Some short-term interruptions and delays can be expected during this work.

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions.

Garbage and recycling

If access for waste collection is interrupted by construction, the contractor will collect homeowner bins and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark all bins with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
