



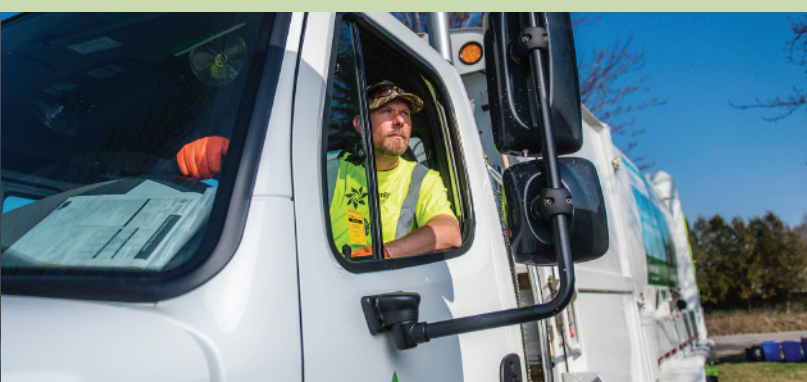

## About Waste Management in Oxford

Oxford County provides curbside garbage collection to approximately 52,000 households across all eight area municipalities. Organics (green bin) collection is currently available in the City of Woodstock and Township of South-West Oxford. Collection in those two communities is delivered by the municipality, and by a third-party contractor in all other areas.

As of January 2026, residential blue box collection is managed by Circular Materials on behalf of the private sector.

# Large Item Collection


Oxford County's Large Item Collection takes place each spring, providing residents with a convenient way to dispose of items that are too large for regular garbage collection or would require a trip to a Waste Management Facility.





 Set out items by 7 a.m. the Monday of your collection week. Late set outs may not be collected.

 The max weight for any item is 45 kg or 100 lbs.

 Do not place small items on larger items. Inaccessible material will be left.

 Items must be on your property, not across roads/ditches, and easily visible (clear of tall grass).

 Place items no more than one metre from the curb.

 Residents are responsible for unacceptable items left behind and/or late set outs.

## Does your item qualify?

- Does your item weigh more than 45 kg (100 lbs)?
  - Can it be broken down easily into a garbage bag?
  - Is there another recycling program in place for this item?
  - Is your item small but you have a large quantity?
- If you answered "yes" to any of these questions, your item does **NOT** qualify.

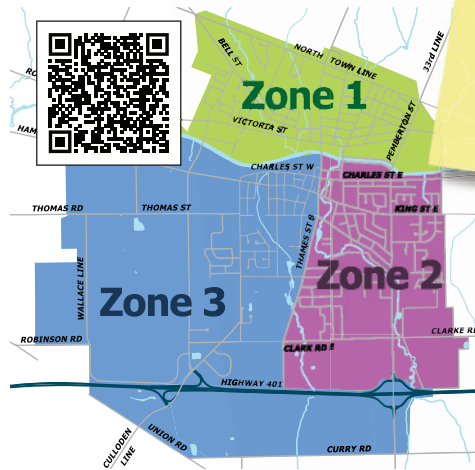

### 2026

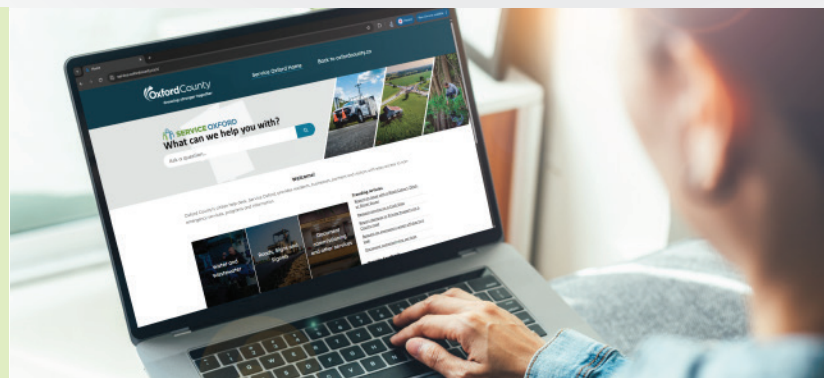
Multi-residential facilities with six (6) or more units (e.g., apartment buildings) are now eligible to register for the green bin organics program.
