Road resurfacing on Oxford Road 59 in Township of East Zorra-Tavistock

Oxford Road 59 will be restricted to one lane between Oxford Road 8 and Oxford Road 17 for road resurfacing

Oxford County has awarded a contract to GIP Paving of Petersburg for road resurfacing on Oxford Road 59 between Oxford Road and Oxford Road 17 in the Township of East Zorra-Tavistock. The work includes asphalt milling, cold-in-place asphalt recycling, hot mix asphalt resurfacing, granular roadside shouldering, and pavement markings. This work will be completed in stages and includes periods of inactive work between operations.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in June and be completed by September. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

Oxford Road 59 will be restricted to one lane of traffic controlled by traffic control persons and a pilot vehicle during the contractors working hours.

During non-working hours traffic will be reinstated to two lanes.

The contractor will be required to maintain access as best as possible to all properties. Some short-term interruptions and delays can be expected during this work.

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions.

Garbage and recycling

If access for waste collection is interrupted by construction, the contractor will collect homeowner bins and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark all bins with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
