Culvert replacement on Oxford Road 14 in Norwich Township

Oxford Road 14 between Oxford Road 59 and Oxford Road 40 (Curries Road) will be closed for a culvert replacement

Oxford County has awarded a contract to County Line Construction of Jarvis, Ontario, for a culvert replacement on Oxford Road 14, between Oxford Road 59 and Oxford Road 40 (Curries Road) in Norwich. The work includes removal of the existing culvert and roadway, temporary rerouting of the waterway, installation of a new concrete culvert and restoration of the roadway.

Work is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of August 24 and is expected to be completed by mid-November 2026. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

During construction, Oxford Road 14 will be closed to through traffic. Traffic will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services. The contractor will be required to maintain access as best as possible to all properties. Some short-term interruptions and delays can be expected during this work.

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions. There will be a planned detour route in place for the duration of the road closure including applicable detour signage.

Detour: Oxford Road 59, Middletown Line and Oxford Road 40 (Curries Road)

Garbage and Recycling

If access for waste collection is interrupted by construction, the contractor will collect homeowner bins and containers and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark garbage and recycling containers with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
