Culvert replacements on Oxford Road 10 in Township of South-West Oxford

Oxford Road 10 will be closed between Oxford Road 27 (Prouse Road) and Oxford Road 20 (Brownsville Road) for culvert replacements

Oxford County has awarded a contract to Steve Smith Construction for culvert replacements on Oxford Road 10 between Oxford Road 27 (Prouse Road) and Oxford Road 20 (Brownsville Road) in the Township of South-West Oxford. The work includes culvert replacements and restoration work as required to be completed in two phases:

Phase 1: Between Oxford Road 27 (Prouse Road) and Ostrander Road

Phase 2: Between Ostrander Road and Oxford Road 20 (Brownsville Road)

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in mid-September and be completed by the end of November. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on site conditions, contractor availability and other factors.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

Oxford Road 10 between Oxford Road 27 (Prouse Road) and Oxford Road 20 (Brownsville Road) will be closed to through traffic during culvert replacements. Traffic will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services.

Phase 1 detour: Oxford Road 27 (Prouse Road), Dereham Line, Ostrander Road

Phase 2 detour: Ostrander Road, Dereham Line, Oxford Road 20 (Brownsville Road)

The contractor will be required to maintain access as best as possible to all properties. Some short-term interruptions and delays can be expected during this work.

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions.

Garbage and recycling

If access for waste collection is interrupted by construction, the contractor will collect homeowner bins and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark all bins with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.

Safety

Please help keep our community and workers safe: respect work zones, obey traffic signs, and maintain a safe distance from equipment and vehicles entering and leaving the site.
